

Acts to Revelation: Pentecost

“When the day of Pentecost came, they were all together in one place” (v. 1). Who is the “they” Luke references? Hint: Go back to v. 26.

What came to rest upon each one of them? (v. 3).

They were all filled with what? What happened as a result of this filling? (v. 4)

What promise lies as the background for this filling? (Lk 24:48-49; Acts 1:4-5)

According to v. 5, who was staying in Jerusalem when this happened?

A crowd came together in bewilderment. What caused this crowd’s wonder? (v. 6)

Thought question: What place might have been able to hold such a large crowd (we know that about three thousand were baptized that day)? what might Isaiah 2:1-5 say about this?

When some folks in the crowd made fun of the apostles, what did they think they might be filled with? (v. 13)

Upon whom did God promise to pour out his Spirit?

What prophet foretold these events? (vv. 16-18)

Everyone who does what shall be saved? (v. 21)

How did God accredit Jesus of Nazareth? (v. 22)

Jesus was delivered over to the Jews by God’s what? (v. 23)

Why was it impossible for death to keep its hold on Jesus? Who foresaw this? (vv. 24-28)

Whom did Peter say was dead and buried and his tomb was with the Jews to that very day? (v. 29)

The apostles were witnesses of what? (v. 32)

What has God made Jesus? (v. 36)

When the people were cut to the heart and asked what they should do, what did Peter reply? (v. 38)

To what did the early disciples devote themselves? (v. 42)
